Through the power of the Holy Spirit and partnerships, we have a vision to reach at least 1% of Cambridge and Waterloo Region, Ontario, Canada and the world to embrace the message of the gospel of Jesus. We are on mission with Jesus to turn broken people into whole people who multiply Christ-followers. In short, we are FOR Cambridge because God is for the world. We are a church that loves God, connects with each other and serves the community. We have a big dream moving forward because of God's amazing faithfulness over our past 66 years.

Over the years the church's evangelism and discipleship strategies included door to door, a bus ministry, an Academy and Sunday School program. TBC has identified, trained and sent its own to reach the nations as well as trained numerous interns and pastors.

In 2018, we planted Restoration Church in the south end of the city, and we plan to multiply again in the future. We are currently concluding a recreation of our property to become a community centre for Christ. By God's grace this is completely debt free.

Our church is Spirit-led, Word-faithful and Christ-centered and enjoys a unified sense of expectation for God to do great things in the days ahead. We are a multicultural community representing a mix of conservative theology and evangelistic outreach. We have increased our online presence during COVID19 and desire to grow in digital discipleship but believe that proximity and presence is what we can best offer the world. Our desire is to be a house of prayer that becomes entirely dependent upon the Lord.

We want to be known for what we are for rather than against, particularly being for people to know the joyful benefits of having a relationship with Jesus Christ. We see the gospel as an onramp to knowing Jesus but also the journey of daily grace and dependence upon Him. We are currently asking God to bring us a Worship Director. Could this be you? Are you passionate about Jesus and His church, and about leading people to worship Him? Are you an engaging vocalist and a creative and innovative leader who knows how to love and shepherd people? Would you be able to plan and lead our church in the Sunday morning service experience, so we have vertical, God-centered worship where we sing one another's songs?

By God's strength and blessing, some of the desired outcomes for this role would be:

- In 3 years, have led Temple to become a community where the transcendence and palpable intimate presence of the Lord is sensed when we gather for corporate worship.
- In 2-3 years, have built up a core of musicians and tech leaders.
- In 2-3 years, build up the "farm team" of worship leaders and musicians in our Student Ministries.

An ideal candidate for this role will have at least a bachelor's degree (preferably in Bible or Theology) with training in music and knowledge of A/V Tech with 5+ years in ministry. If you have a love for Jesus, integrity, an insatiable appetite to learn, self-awareness, are a self-starter, and one who can gather people around them on the mission of Christ, then we want to hear from you. Our deep desire is that you would have a joyful 10+ year tenure here at Temple.

You will get to do all of this in a mid-size city with a quaint small-town feel. Cambridge is located within the Region of Waterloo and has a population of 135,000. Cambridge's founding communities have such a rich history that locals refer to themselves as being from Hespeler, Galt or Preston. Even though these communities amalgamated in 1973, the locals still refer to

themselves by their neighborhood and each community gives its own unique contribution to the city of Cambridge. Temple Baptist Church is located in Hespeler. Waterloo Region is famous in part for St. Jacobs which has an underlying Mennonite influence that makes it Christian friendly. The City of Cambridge offers many cultural opportunities, such as live music and theatre. You will never run out of things to do in Cambridge. The city is alive with culture all-year-round. Explore our cultural spaces, including Galleries, Museums, Hamilton Theatre, and Cambridge Centre for the Arts. The film industry has also selected Cambridge as a place to produce many movies and television shows.
