THE FELLOWSHIP BAPTIST CHURCH STORY

Over 76 years ago, Lillian Caffin felt burdened to ask God to begin a new work in Cobourg. God answered her prayers by sending Pastor Robert Russell to our town, and a small but faithful group began meeting at a public hall in downtown Cobourg in 1947. Sweeping up cigarette butts and setting up chairs in the hall, their humble weekly gatherings sparked a desire within the group to reach the Town of Cobourg for Jesus. In 1948, this faithful contingent signed a membership charter with only 20 names, but the group soon began to grow. As they continued to meet and ask God to bless the work He had started, God faithfully provided. Their ministry expanded, and by the 1950s the congregation purchased land on King Street and constructed their own building in the heart of the town. As the church grew, these faithful visionaries remained dedicated to prayer and to ministering to their community, and God continued to move. The original church building was soon bursting at the seams, as more and more people came to hear the Gospel. In God's perfect timing, in 1978 He provided the church's current location on Elgin St. W. and the rest is history - with a few more building additions, countless stories of faithful ministry, and a willingness to follow God's leading. Our church has a rich heritage of faithfully preaching the Word and of willingly embracing change to better proclaim the Gospel to our surrounding community, a heritage that all began with one person's bold and faithful prayers. Although today FBC has multiple church sites and many more congregants than in 1947, our gospel witness and ministry remain firmly anchored and dependent on the faithful prayers of God's people.
