OUR PURPOSE


We provide services to diverse populations and have experience dealing with high-risk behaviors/lifestyles. We are uniquely suited as advocates and recognize the importance of early intervention. It is very important that vulnerable, at-risk youth and young adults have access to positive influences and information so they can make positive life-affirming choices for themselves.

We are a not-for-profit faith-based organization providing limited health services to clients free of charge.

We provide pregnancy support services, routine testing and treatment of STIs, and health education. These services include prenatal care, parenting support, material assistance, post abortive healing, peer support groups and men's and women's peer mentoring.
