Cornerstone Baptist Church is a Christ-exalting, Bible-believing, multi-generational church in the heart of Orillia, Ontario, Canada. As with all other churches, our mission is to make disciples of Jesus Christ. One of the ways we express our sense of vision is through the phrase, "Overflow Church". - 3) We believe in the essential importance of **Giving** to the work of the Church; by giving financially and by giving our time by serving others.
- 4) We believe in the essential importance of **Going** for the sake of the gospel; by going on mission to share Christ in our workplaces and neighbourhoods, and to go where the gospel of Christ is not proclaimed.

Cornerstone Baptist Church is prayerfully seeking our next Pastor of Worship. In this role you will oversee all aspects of Sunday morning worship in collaboration with our Lead Pastor Paul Carter. You will also be involved in a complementary ministry role according to your gifts and passions.



OUR PHILOSOPHY OF WORSHIP.

Worship is the submission of all our nature to God. It is the loving and grateful response of human beings to God. Worship therefore involves all of who we are as people, and yet it is appropriate to speak in a more narrow sense about what we do as a group when we gather together on the Lord's Day.

We desire our worship to be...

God-centred

Worship is about orienting ourselves toward the source and centre of all reality. It is about hearing from God and agreeing wholeheartedly with what he says. Our worship will aspire to focus the attention of all those present upon the holiness, goodness, and beauty of Almighty God.

Christ-Exalting

As fallen human beings we are only able to approach our Holy Creator through the person and work of Christ. In our times of worship, we will celebrate all of what God has done to redeem us, paying particular attention to the finished work of Christ. Therefore, He will be the hero of the testimonies we share, and it will be His honour and glory we seek above all others.

Spirit-Empowered

The Bible teaches that all truly saved people are filled with the Holy Spirit of God and are thus capable of speaking words that encourage and edify the Body of Christ. Hence worship on the Lord's Day is not intended to showcase the gifts of the few, but to activate, cultivate and deploy the gifts of all. The church is not a kingdom with priests, it is a kingdom of priests and therefore we will emphasize plurality and gift-based ministry in our times of corporate worship.

Scripture-Based

The Bible is our final authority in all matters of faith and practice; it therefore serves as the normative standard for the doctrine, shape, and tone of gathered worship. This does not require that every element of a service be prescribed in detail in Scripture, but it does require that the substance of worship be regulated by biblical truth and ordered according to sanctified wisdom. The whole gathering should be saturated with Scripture in its readings, prayers, songs, confessions, and benedictions, so that the entire service becomes an arena of divine address and congregational response.

Elder-discerned

The Bible describes a balance of Spirit-led participation and Spirit-empowered discernment within corporate worship. We understand the task of discernment to be the responsibility of the elders. As such, we understand that the elders are to take the lead in teaching and also to exercise leadership and discernment over all those who are engaged in this important ministry.

Congregationally-engaged

Worship involves speaking to God and speaking to one another, as Colossians 3:16-17 says: "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." Worship must be acceptable to God and engaging with the entire congregation.
